



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

**Armenian American Sports Medicine Coalition, USA**

And

**Armenian State Institute of Physical Culture and Sport, Armenia**

Hereinafter collectively referred to as “Parties” or individually referred to as “Party.”

### **1. Purpose**

To establish the terms and conditions under which the Parties will declare a professional

This Memorandum of Understanding (‘MoU’) therefore, contributes to the joint pursuit of education and research, specifically, in the development of an Athletic Therapy education program at the Armenian State Institute of Physical Culture and Sport in Yerevan, Armenia.

### **2. Areas of cooperation**

Parties, wishing to promote cooperation in education and research, agree to explore:

- a. cooperation on academic program development, specifically in the development and establishment of an Athletic Therapy education program;
- b. the development of Athletic Therapy research capabilities, and joint research ventures where applicable and agreeable by both Parties;
- c. the exchange of information, including the results of educational and research collaboration;
- d. any other activities viewed by and agreed upon by both Parties to be mutually beneficial.

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this MoU will be mutually discussed and agreed by the Parties prior to acting and will be the subject of an addendum to this MoU.

### **3. Duration and renewal of MoU**

This MoU becomes effective from the day the representatives of the Parties affix their signatures below, and will continue for an initial period of one year, whereupon it will be reviewed and may be extended by a mutual written agreement of the parties. This MoU may be amended by written consent of the Parties and may be terminated by either Party upon giving one month written notice.

### **4. Use of name and logos**

Any use of the names ‘Armenian American Sports Medicine Coalition’ or ‘Armenian State Institute of Physical Culture and Sport’, including any of its constituent schools, departments, programs or logos, relating in any way to the activities or joint activities described in this MoU, is subject to written approval by both parties.

**5. Assignment**

This MoU will be personal to the Parties hereto and no Party will have the right to assign or transfer any right or obligation hereunder in whole or partially to any third party without prior written consent of the other Party.

**6. Dispute resolution**

If a problem or dispute arises between the Parties, they will first seek to resolve that problem or dispute between themselves to the best of their endeavors, and will use all efforts required to settle the problem or dispute by direct negotiation. If the problem or dispute cannot be resolved in this manner, the Parties may elect a third party by mutual consent, who will examine the problem or dispute and provide recommendations.

This MoU has been drafted in English, with one copy issued to each Party.
